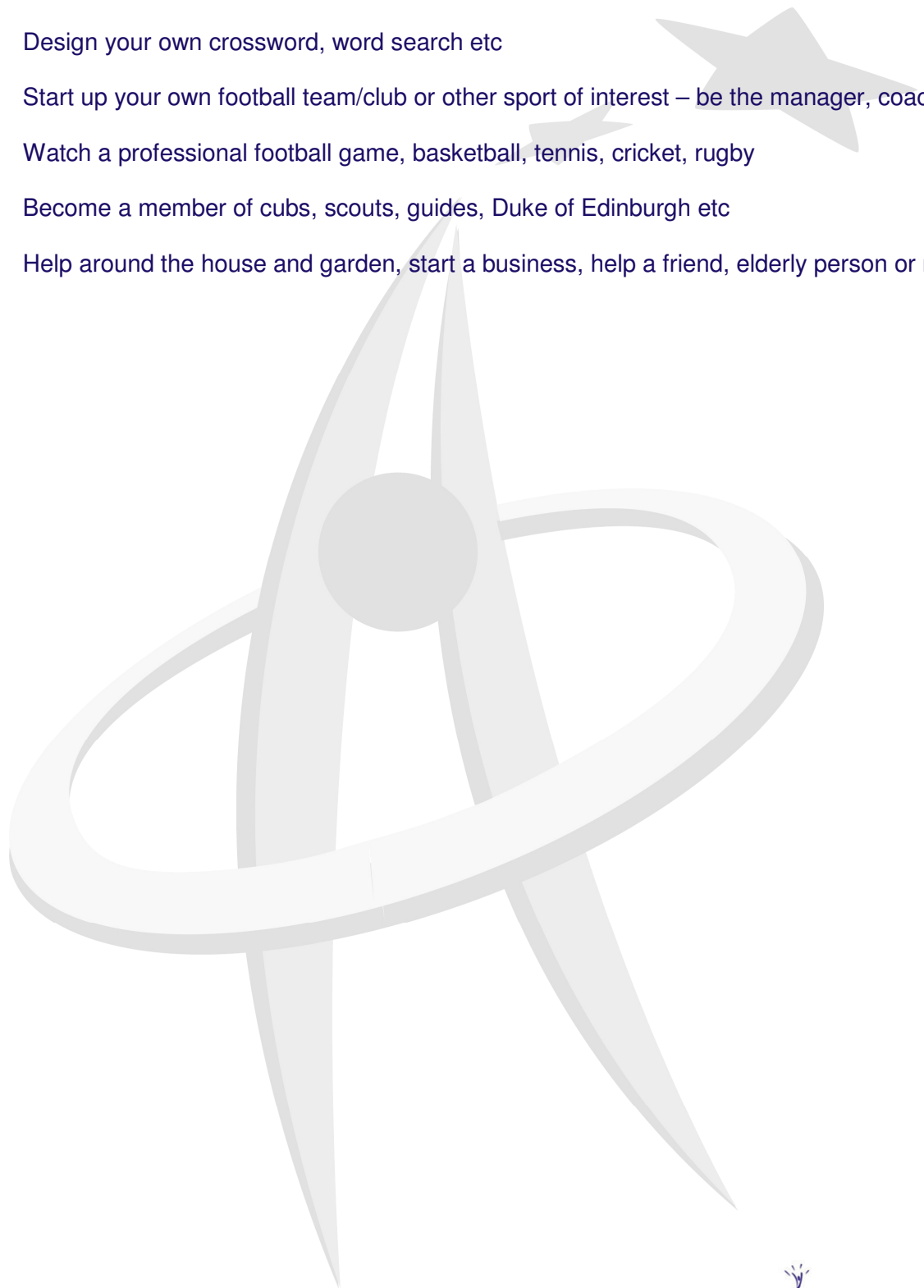
ACTIVITY IDEAS FOR PRIMARY CHILDREN

- Research the internet on topics of specific interest to child
- Design a website at home or in school or for a club
- Design a magazine/newspaper on the computer
- Take part in creative activities at home, e.g. experiment with colour/texture/mediums
- Science experiments (with adult supervision)
- Use the “Thinking out of the Box” resource file by Chris Henshaw www.thinkingoutofabox.co.uk
- Visit the theatre, opera, ballet, concerts, museums or galleries – write or take photo's, drawings
- Visit Discovery Centre/Space Centre/Air Museum
- Theatre Productions – go behind the scenes, join the education programme
- Write music, lyrics, stories, poetry, rhymes, rap
- Play an instrument, use a camera, make a video of something that interests you
- Become a member of a band/orchestra or a writers/poetry group, art club
- Join clubs, e.g. Chess/theatre/music/maths/science/computer – in or out of school
- Take part in activity weekends and summer schools
- Become a school representative/spokesperson
- Mentor a friend at school
- Start a collection of something of particular interest, e.g. cars/trains/fossils/crystals/stamps
- Visit the library/bookshop
- Read a book, go brass rubbing
- Read specialist magazines
- Practice very hard spellings, Sudoku, word searches, crosswords, monopoly, scrabble, Rubik's
- Try the crosswords or puzzles in the Guardian/Times newspapers and others
