Snapshot of 'Study Camp - University-based Multi-disciplinary Study Projects'

The 'Study Camp - University-based Multi-disciplinary Study Projects' jointly organized by the Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education (HKAGE) and the Hong Kong University of Science & Technology (UST) was completed smoothly at UST on 30 December 2008. The Study Camp aims to let the student members exchange ideas and demonstrate their group study results from the 'University-based Multi-disciplinary Study Projects', and improve their presentation skills and abilities. The Camp includes an introduction, group presentation and presentation of certificates and awards. 52 student members, coordinators and staff participated in the event.

The event started with the opening speech by Mr. Abraham Tang, Associate Director (Student Programmes & Services) of HKAGE. Mr. Tang, who was one of the judges for the event, encouraged the students to grasp the learning opportunities and do their best to develop their potential. Students were deeply impressed and benefited by his words. After the speech, various groups began their presentation. Before the group presentation in the afternoon, another judge, Prof NG Tai Kai, Associate Dean of School of Science and Head of Physics Department of UST, shared the story about a famous calligraphist to emphasize the importance of creativity and originality. Results were announced after the students' voting and the 1st Group on 'U.S. Presidential Election 2008' won the 'Best Report Award' and the 5th Group on 'Physics in Everyday Life' was honoured the 'Best Presentation Award'. The two judges were invited to present the awards and certificates.
