

7th Pan-Pearl River Delta and Chinese Elite Schools Physics Olympiad 2011**HKAGE student member wins the *Best Contestant* Category**

As a good start in the year of the Rabbit, student members of The Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education (HKAGE) won 16 first prizes, 19 second prizes and 16 third prizes at the 7th Pan-Pearl River Delta plus Chinese Elite Schools Physics Olympiad out of a total of 57 entrants.

An outstanding performance has been achieved by **Cheung Hil Fung Harry**, a student at Diocesan Boys' School. This Form 5 student stood out from 358 participants as the ***Best Contestant***, the second of its kind for Hong Kong after 2008. Prof. Yang Zhi Yu, the Chairman of the Hong Kong Physics Olympiad Committee said "The questions of this year were more difficult than those of last year but Cheung Hil Fung Harry achieved a higher score than the record of last year. The Hong Kong contestants also have achieved the best results since the contest first started in 2005".

The 57 Hong Kong participants were trainees of the **Physics Enhancement Programme** organised by the HKAGE. They were selected to join the contest after taking part in a series of physics enhancement courses. Cheung Hil Fung Harry commented "The stimulating Physics Enhancement Programme has consolidated my basic knowledge in physics which has equipped me well to go for the contest. The programme also provided us with a valuable chance to exchange ideas among the gifted students under an encouraging study environment".

The contest was jointly organised by the Hong Kong Physics Olympiad Committee, the Physics Teaching Professional Commission of the Chinese Society of Education and the Macau Physics Olympiad Committee. The aim is to promote physics education and provide challenging learning opportunities for the youth who are gifted in physics in the Mainland, Hong Kong, Macau and Taipei.
