Mathematics in 18 Lessons 2011

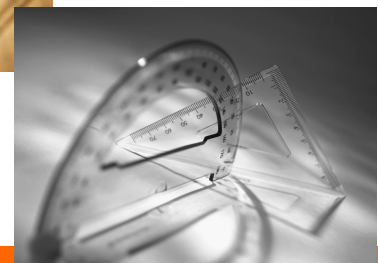
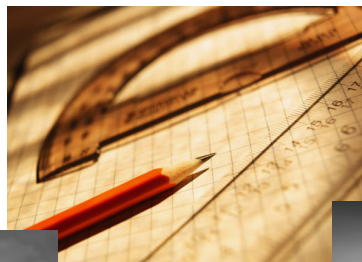
Phase I
