

**HKAGE student members stand out at
the 6th Pan-Pearl River Delta plus Chinese Elite Schools Physics Olympiad**

As a good start in the year of Tiger, Hong Kong secondary school students won two first prizes, one second prize and 18 third prizes in the Integrated Test at the 6th Pan-Pearl River Delta plus Chinese Elite Schools Physics Olympiad. Among the majority Secondary Six contestants, the second prize winner is only a Secondary Four student who outperformed many of his fellows.

Prof. Yang Zhi Yu said that the Hong Kong contestants did just as well as before although there is no top-three scorer from Hong Kong this year. Considering that Hong Kong contestants have only been trained for a short period of time, as compared to the one or two years of everyday training received by a typical mainland student, the results of the Hong Kong contestants are very satisfactory.

The competition was jointly organised by the Hong Kong Physics Olympiad Committee and the Physics Teaching Professional Commission of the Chinese Society of Education. The competition aimed to promote physics education and provide challenging learning opportunities for the youth who are gifted in physics in the Mainland, Hong Kong, Macau and Taipei.

The Olympiad was held simultaneously at the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, the University of Macau and the Shenzhen Middle School in the Mainland on February 19 of 2010. The contest was divided into two levels: the Integrated Test (at International Physics Olympiad level) and the Basic Test (covers only mechanics for junior secondary school students).

Among the 348 talented participants, 242 were elites from secondary schools in the Mainland and 80 came from Macau.

The 26 Hong Kong participants were trainees of the Physics Enhancement Programme co-organised by the Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education. With outstanding performance in the Hong Kong Physics Olympiad 2009, most of them were subsequently selected to take part in a series of enhancement courses and to join the competition.
