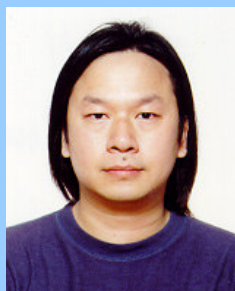


Humanities Seminar
