We emphasize both theory and practice. Through **workshops** and **adventurous camp**, gifted students with leadership potential will acquire a deeper understanding on themselves and the groups they belong to. In which, they will strengthen their leadership skills and enhance their personal development. After that, student will take a step forward to the community. With all these, students will **enrich** their **understanding towards society**, being caring and responsible to the others, and **reinforce** their **commitment to society**.

Course Objectives

- Acquire a deeper understanding on the qualities of leaders for the new generation
- Be nurtured with solid fundamental knowledge of leadership skills
- Enhance their self-understanding on strengths and weaknesses of being a leader
- Strengthen their self-confidence, critical thinking and reasoning skills, interpersonal skills, analytical skills, as well as problem solving skills
- Increase their understanding on their living community and so as to society
- Be nurtured with a sense of commitment and responsibility towards the community

Course Content

1. Five Workshops

- *Qualities of a Successful Leader*
- *Self Understanding and Emotional Quotient*

2. Onsite visit with Frontline Social Workers or Representatives from NGOs in addressing major social issue

3. Two Adventurous and Experiential Camps

Through adventure-based activities, students can taste the experience of creative problem solving skills, overcoming challenges, personal breakthrough, as well as development, concepts, attitudes, cooperation and communication in teams.

4. Community Investigation Project (5-6 students per group)

Students will be required to work as teams to write up a report in addressing a particular community issue in the designated community.

5. Project Presentation Seminar

Teams of students have to submit the project report and share their experience in the seminar.

6. Appreciation Ceremony, Conclusion and Way Forward

Students will be assisted to set up goals and objectives for their further development in the session.
