graduated from the University of Hong Kong in 1973 with a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degree in economics and history. Mr Ma has held senior management positions in international financial institutions and Hong Kong publicly listed companies in his career. In July 2002, he left the private sector and joined the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region as the Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury and assumed the post of Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development in July 2007. He resigned from the Government in July 2008 due to medical reasons. In October 2008, he was appointed as an Honorary Professor of the School of Economics and Finance at the University of Hong Kong. In July 2009, he was appointed as a Member of the International Advisory Council of China Investment Corporation. At present, he is the Chairman and non-executive director of China Strategic Holdings Limited, a Hong Kong listed company. He is also a director of Husky Energy Inc. and an independent non-executive Director of China Resources Land Ltd.
