## **Intended Learning Outcomes**

Upon completion of the programme, participants should be able to:

1. Enhance understanding in the operation of the HKSAR Government, the functions of Principal Officials;
2. Elevate competence in analysis and critical thinking for raise in learning efficacy and personal advancement;
3. Gain exposure to public policy and governance, and strike a balance between distinctive opinions from stakeholders;
4. Enrich knowledge in public governance and cultivate a sense of responsibility to society.

## ◆ Introduction

Public policy making impacts societal development widely. Through the Programme, students will enhance understanding on governmental operation, functions of principal officials, and the making progress of public policies. Students will also be able to understand the basic theory and framework of policy making. Students will investigate deep in public policy implementation, Game (balancing interests of stakeholders), and policy assessment through case studies. They will acquire skills in multi-angle thinking, policy analysis, and fundamental methods of public policy research. Their presentation and public speaking capacity will also be elevated through a series of practice. Content of the Programme includes Introduction and Symposiums, Policy Research Workshops, and Mock Policy Making Workshops. The Programme is co-organized by HKAGE and The Arete.
