<b>Introduction</b>	<p><b>Who says "1+1=2"?</b></p> <p><b>We dare to think, dare to act, dare to innovate, making "1+1&gt;2" possible.</b></p> <p>"1+1" Group is a parent-child programme for primary gifted students and their parents. The programme design is based on the Creative Problem Solving (CPS) model (Isaken, Treffinger, Dorval, &amp; Nollar, 2000), and infused affective elements such as parent-child communication, self-understanding, exploration of value systems and peer learning in an interactive learning environment. Through this programme parents and children can enhance their creative problem-solving skills, make innovations and achieve breakthroughs. Children and their peers also have opportunities to communicate, collaborate and share their achievements through a range of activities. They will learn to appreciate each other and enhance their problem solving, collaboration, questioning, presentation, and multi-perspective thinking skills.</p>
