# Minecraft Tour 2022: Hong Kong intangible cultural heritage

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## **Intended Learning Outcomes**

Upon completion of the programme, participants should be able to:

- 1. Identify the historical and cultural characteristics of at least 2 intangible cultural heritages in Hong Kong
- 2. Understand the basic operation and construction skills of MINECRAFT JAVA Edition
- 3. Create at least 1 student-initiated work with MINECRAFT
- 4. Enhance communication skills and teamwork through different hands-on group activities
- 5. Develop self-learning attitude and learning motivation
- 6. Develop appreciation to the value of Hong Kong intangible cultural heritage



## Introduction

In 2017, the Intangible Cultural Heritage Office of Hong Kong Government has announced the first representative list of the intangible cultural heritage of Hong Kong today. There are 20 items listed, for example Chinese Opera, Tin Hau Festival and the Tai Hang Fire Dragon Dance. Have you ever seen, visit or knew historical background of them? Do you wish to build one of them by using MINECRAFT?

This course will bring students to experience a journey to explore the uniqueness and history of the Hong Kong intangible cultural heritage through the lens of MINECRAFT. Students could learn the advanced MINECRAFT functions and use real-virtual projection, and Google Map to create a 1:1 ratio of Hong Kong intangible cultural heritage (an attraction or a building) as a group by applying the MINECRAFT skills and knowledge obtained.

Grasp this chance to build your world with fascinating heritage and appreciate the beauty of traditions!
