

- 2) Attendance requirements:
 - (i) Certificates for Phase II Training will ONLY be issued to those students who are selected from Phase I to Phase II (subject to their performance in Phase Test (1) and Module Test (1)) AND have attended 13 out of 20 sessions in Phase II (Sessions 18-37). For HKAGE members, only the students who are selected will have a learning record in their Student Learning Profile.
 - (ii) HKAGE has adopted an Online Attendance Taking System. Please follow the procedures in the "<u>User Manual for Students</u>" to report attendance before every session. Regarding attendance and leave policy, please click here.
 - (iii) Students will not be promoted to next phase if they do not satisfy the above attendance requirement.
 - (iv) Besides, students may not be promoted to next phase if they do not attend the Affective Support session.
- 3) The learning attitude and in-class behaviour of student, collaboration with others in the training programme will also be under consideration in the selection process to next phase.
- 4) The assessment consists of
 - Biology Workshop Group Project ---- 15%
 - Chemistry Lab Project ----- 15%
 - Phase Test (2) ----- 70%
- 5) None of the assessment will be rescheduled after announcement of the official schedule.
- 6) Only <u>selected lecture materials</u> will be uploaded to Google Drive 4-8 working days after the lecture.
- 7) Special arrangement is ONLY considered ONCE for a student who is not able to join the scheduled assessment if
 - (i) they are representing Hong Kong (or potentially will represent Hong Kong) to participate in some international competitions, or in some screening processes which are related to those international competitions; AND
 - (ii) those competitions are organized by EDB or HKAGE; AND
 - (iii) those competitions are recognised by both EDB and HKAGE as legitimate for granting special arrangement.
 - IJSO-HK Screening Steering Committee will make the final decision whether to approve a special arrangement or not.
- 8) No attendance exemption is granted due to any reasons (such as illness, participation of important events/competitions/examinations).
- 9) If a student cannot attend a class, he/she should send an absence notice to HKAGE in advance. Note that such a notice is not equivalent to absence application nor attendance exemption since, according to (8), there is no attendance exemption. The notice is to enable the teacher to have better arrangement of the lesson.

- 10) The decision of IJSO-HK Screening Steering Committee shall be final and conclusive.
- 11) Phase III training: Jul 2021 Nov 2022 (tentative)
