Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the programme, participants should be able to:

1. identify and explain the concept of symbols from visual narratives;
2. critically examine the association of science and philosophy sphere;
3. articulate the interpretation and relationship between symbols and life experience from major identified areas;
