Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the programme, participants should be able to:

1. explain the purpose of forensic science, i.e. identification, individualization, and reconstruction;
2. resolve important information from different physical evidences, including fingerprint, hair & fibre, bloodstain pattern, and DNA;
3. utilize analyzed evidences to properly identify and rebuild what occurred in particular situations;
4. apply the scientific process skills to answer questions and solve problems within forensic contexts;
5. maintain high integrity when handling evidences.



◆ Introduction

The programme consists of three phases. There are 9 sessions in Phase 1 that integrates the concepts learned in biology, chemistry, and physics to strengthen students' skills in scientific reasoning, observation and experimental skills. Participants will learn and experience the analysis of various evidences, including fingerprints, hair & fibre, bloodstain pattern and DNA. Participants who completed Phase 1 with outstanding performance will be invited to join Phase 2.

Phase 2 & 3 are tentatively scheduled as below:

Phase 2: Saturdays from 28 Jan to 18 Mar 2023

Phase 3: Saturdays from 1 Apr to 21 May 2023
