- 3. Outline the advantages and disadvantages of different Cloud platforms and the state of the Cloud Computing market;
- 4. Explain Cloud Computing concerns, cost management, development and operations (DevOps) principles;
- 5. Demonstrate data literacy skills.



#### Introduction

I believe everyone has heard or even used "Google Drive" and "Dropbox". These examples of Cloud Computing applications have had a significant impact on our daily lives, not only bringing convenience to the public, but also helping businesses to save costs and improve efficiency.

This course is divided into three levels. After the participants are assessed and successfully meet the relevant requirements, they will be certified by the Qualifications Framework (Level 2) and promoted to the next level. The course covers the basic theory and technology of cloud computing, as well as the applications in real life. Activities included: Open-ended discussions, hands-on activities, group research and presentations, and extracurricular experiences to strengthen students' higher-order thinking, creativity and problem-solving skills, and to gain more comprehensive training in soft skills and deepen their understanding of the technology industry.
