### **Intended Learning Outcomes**

Upon completion of the programme, participants should be able to:

1. experience situations faced by children in war by participating in simulation regarding humanitarian challenges;
2. perceive humanitarian consequences brought by war;
3. ponder ways to practice humanitarian actions in daily life.



## ◆ Introduction

In an unusual 90-minute journey, you will step onto a ruthless battlefield; you will experience the taste of despair, as well as the glimpse of hope.

In a world of armed conflicts and hostility, you constantly face fear, pain and hunger. Suddenly, a group of guerrillas barge into your hideout. If you stay, you may be forced to be a child soldier, who will face endless coldblooded killings and tortures. If you flee, where else can you go?

Being in complete darkness, will you get the chance to see a shred of light? Who will be there to lend you a helping hand?

The Red Cross Humanitarian Education Centre of The Hong Kong Red Cross Headquarters is the first exploration zone on the war in Asia. Through a series of authentic experience and stories, the horror and misery of war are revealed in front of the participants, which enable them to understand war is not far-reaching, everyone can help regardless of their background, and everyone can take humanitarian actions to address the challenges.

## ◆ Application Procedure

This programme is Programmes with No Screening.

There are no screening questions, written test or other screening methods for this type of programmes.

- Student members can select up to 5 programmes from a list of selection. Applicants have to state the priority when submitting the application. (1st priority, 2nd priority, 3rd priority, etc). 1 token is required for each programme

- The application can only be submitted once. After submission of the application, the programme selection and the priority cannot be changed;
- If a student member removes a programme from the application before the application deadline by withdrawal, the choice priority will remain unchanged. (For example: A student has selected three programmes and removed the programme with the 1st priority from the application. The choices of 2nd and 3rd priority will remain unchanged with no promotion in priority);
- We will select the students based on the student's choice of priorities and a randomly generated selection by the computer system. If there is time clash between the applied programme and other programmes with offer, HKAGE will consider if the application will be accepted;
- Student members should avoid applying programmes with time clash;
- The decision of HKAGE on the result of selection should be final.
