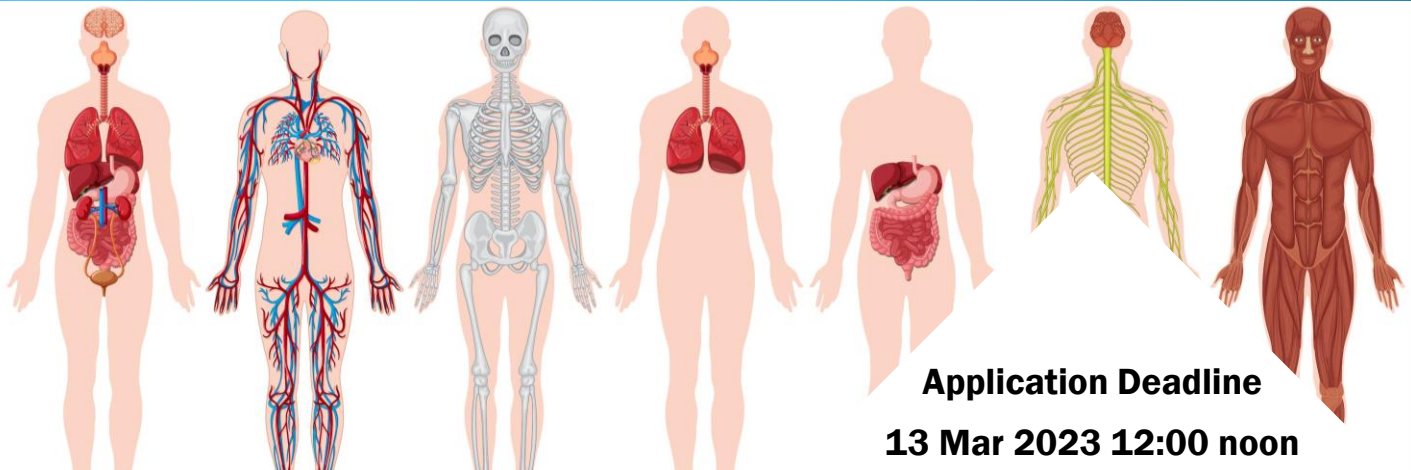

Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the programme, participants should be able to:

1. figure out the human body and structure from the preserved human specimens;
2. explain the fundamental knowledge of anatomy and dissection;
3. appreciate a selfless concern for the well-being of others from the silent teachers.



◆ Introduction

The Human Anatomy Museum of The University of Hong Kong was set up in the 60s by School of Biomedical Sciences of The University of Hong Kong, providing opportunities for students who are studying the healthcare professions (including medicine, nursing, pharmacy, Chinese medicine, and dentistry). The preserved human specimens exhibit at the Human Anatomy Museum are donated by “silent teachers” (body donors).

In this talk, students can explore the basic facilities and equipment of the Human Anatomy Museum and Dissecting Laboratory, understand the human body and structure through the preserved human specimens. Also, the staff will briefly introduce the Body Donation Programme of HKU.

Remarks: The preserved human specimens belong to real human cadavers which may cause uneasiness. Students must evaluate whether their psychological quality and acceptance are suitable for participating in this activity. <https://www.sbms.hku.hk/education/undergraduate-education/anatomy-museum>
