Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the programme, participants should be able to:

2. Build a peer and professional network with Masters and other participants;
3. Become more committed and capable of creating a better world and society through problem solving, research, action and innovation;
5. Explore talents, develop skills and qualities, and broaden horizons.



◆ Introduction

HKGAP is a 2 - years & unique mentorship programme of The Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education(HKAGE), which provides students with an individualised and very privileged learning opportunity. One of the unique features of the HKGAP is the engagement of an apprentice and a master on a student self-initiated & specialised project. Apprentice is required to communicate with their Master on a regular basis and report on the progress of their project. Each apprentice must complete the selected self-initiated & specialised project before the end of the HKGAP and present the project results in different formats such as papers, lectures, workshops, etc.

- F1 to F5 HKAGE student members only in 2022/23 school year. Priority will be given to students with existing project or research
- Profound knowledge & exceptional motivation in a specific and self-identified interest field
- Strong intrinsic interest in developing their skills within an interest field in a long-term support programme
- High initiation in arrangement and attending all HKAGE activities and events

Selection interview

HKAGE will conduct a preliminary assessment based on the content of the Learning Proposal and invite appropriate participants for interview by email. (If participants do not receive the interview notice, it is considered a failure thesis.)

◆ Certificate

E-Certificate will be awarded to participants who complete the programme and demonstrate strong commitment throughout.
