The main functions of the Legislative Council are to enact, amend or repeal laws; examine and approve budgets, taxation, and public expenditure; and raise questions on the work of the government.

This workshop aims to provide students with basic knowledge about the Legislature. Students will join a guided tour of the Legislative Council Complex to understand the conference facilities and education facilities in the Complex, followed by tailored face-to-face education activities:

1. Presentation on the composition and functions of the Legislative Council; and
2. Interactive games to introduce the law-making process and discuss various current issues with students
