Regular script originated between the Eastern Han dynasty and Three Kingdoms period. It is square in style with distinctive strokes. The regular script is still a very common style for beginners to practice calligraphy. In this course, participant will learn general grounding in regular script.

Mr Lau Hok-ching is an experienced and well-known Chinese calligrapher in Hong Kong. In the last two decades, Mr Lau has hosted more than 10 exhibitions displaying both his own work and that of his students. He is also invited to provide calligraphy course in tertiary education. He has taught more than thousand students.
