Jury System is one of the most important features of Hong Kong's legal system is trial by jury, i.e. trial in court by fellow members of the community of the person on trial. Jurors are Hong Kong non-legal experts residents and their duties decide whether the defendant is guilty or not guilty based on the facts in a criminal trial. In a death inquest, jurors decide the cause and circumstances connected with a death.

Students from the Faculty of Law of The University of Hong Kong (HKU) would design and conduct this talk under the guidance of the Faculty of Law supervisor and the scheme of the Rule of Law Education Project (ROLE) which is one of the Knowledge Exchange initiatives of the Faculty of Law of HKU.
