Upon completion of the programme, participants should be able to:

- 1. explain what collage and sketching is;
- 2. create and present a collage and sketching artwork in group;
- 3. enhance their observation skills and creative thinking through artwork creation.



Introduction

Cutting, tearing, and pasting seem to be simple skills, but they are the ways to learn how to choose and simplify the ideas and artworks. This course will start from Cubism by illustrating the collage and sketching skills from artists such as Picasso. Then the tutor will address the concept of "Surface" and teach students how to pick up the materials they need, to build up their artwork gradually. Students will improve their observation skills via artwork appreciation and practice.

Ms. Pun Hok Kan started her career in early childhood education and learn paintings from famous artist Marco Szeto. Now, she focuses on artwork creation and promotion of different art forms. The first collage exhibition Hokkan participated in was 'Pasting Colour' shown at Taikoo Place in 2007. In 2009, she participated in the Fourth PolyU Arts Festival Mural Painting Project of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University. In 2015, she joined the 'Cuba Touch' multimedia exhibition at Dare to Dream Art Gallery Macau. In 2019, she was one of the three artists who coexhibited at an exhibition entitled 'Colourscape' at the Yan Gallery. In 2022, the first solo exhibition 'In the Breeze' at Marco Szeto Studio.
