This requires them to have a Transformative Mindset, which empowers leaders to view difficulties as challenges and to develop a habit of success.

This Introductory Module serves as a foundation for cultivating the mindset of future leaders in the digital era, incorporating the Data and Transformative Mindsets to overcome challenges and adapt to changes during times of uncertainty. Students who completed the introductory module will be eligible to apply for the enhancement module.


