Upon completion of the programme, participants should be able to:

- 1. demonstrate a basic understanding of various legal perspectives, including Hong Kong Legal System, Hong Kong Civil Procedure and Tort Law;
- 2. apprehend the difference between the skill of public speaking and advocacy; and mock trial and mooting;
- 3. identify the potential legal issues in the society;
- 4. construct and critically examine the legal agreements;
- 5. reconstruct the connection between social and legal issues in daily life.

## Introduction

Law does not exist in a vacuum. It is highly relevant to the community we live in. This is especially true for tort law which is an area of law that touches our daily life, from personal injuries to harassment and defamation.

Through this programme, participants will not only acquire basic understanding of the Hong Kong Legal System, but also learn how to identify potential legal issues in their everyday life. They will also have the opportunity to learn about the basic principles of tort law and use such understanding to examine and construct basic legal arguments in a moot court setting.

This programme will be conducted using the Street Law methodology, which involves using highly interactive and engaging activities to break down complex legal principles into easily understandable concepts.
