Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

- 1. explore the impacts and characteristics of news reporting and understand the criteria of assessing news value;
- 2. document social events of their interest through interviewing and writing;
- 3. verify the authenticity of news from different perspectives, sources, and tools.
