Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

1. Recognise the objectives and schedule of the Hong Kong Gifted Apprentice Programme 2024/26;
2. Predict the learning progress and gains of participating in HKGAP through sharing of apprentices from different cohorts;
3. Discover the possible achievements of participating in HKGAP;
4. Acquire skills to communicate with Masters and other peers.

◆ Introduction

HKGAP is a 2-year and unique mentorship programme of The Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education (HKAGE), which provides students with an individualized and very privileged learning opportunity. One of the unique features of the HKGAP is the engagement of an apprentice and a master on a student self-initiated and specialised project. Apprentice is required to communicate with their Master on a regular basis and report on the progress of their project. Each apprentice must complete the selected self-initiated and specialized project before the end of the HKGAP and present the project results in different formats such as papers, lectures, workshops, etc.

The Sharing Session is a pre-programme for HKGAP 2024/26. The Talent Development Division - Specialisation and Innovation of HKAGE will introduce the structure and schedule of HKGAP 2024/26. Additionally, it will provide an opportunity for apprentices from different cohorts to share what they have learned and their achievements in HKGAP. Tips on master-apprentice communication will also be covered during the session.
