Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

- 1. identify at least three challenge(s) that people with disabilities may encounter in real life situation.
- describe the key indicator(s) of how individuals with disabilities overcome these challenges.
- 3. reflect on personal values and consider ways of treating others with disabilities.
- 4. enhance social awareness and empathy towards people with disabilities.

Gifted Programme Introduction

The workshop will be divided into two parts. Students will first appreciate the movie - "Invisible" Summit" for approximately 90 minutes. The movie mainly tells the story of Zhang Hong (張洪), a visually impaired man from China who climbed to the top of the world's highest peak, Mount Everest, becoming the first blind climber in Asia and the third in the world to achieve this feat. Using documentary techniques, the film chronicles Zhang Hong's entire journey and mental challenges in climbing Mount Everest, from early preparations to his successful summit. Following the film appreciation, there will be a 15-minute sharing time by our HKAGE alumnus, Mr. Sin Long Ching. Mr. Sin is a SEN Support Teacher & Career Guidance Teacher in a mainstream secondary school with experience teaching students with visual impairment at Ebenezer School and Home for the Visually Impaired. He will discuss the challenges faced by visually impaired students in Hong Kong society.

It is hoped that the workshop will enhance students' understanding that everyone faces unique challenges and requires support in different ways.


