Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

- 1. follow the basic rules and manners of a bridge game;
- 2. seek suitable contract with simple opening bids and responses;
- 3. establish potential tricks through different strategies, such as finessing, establishing secondary high cards;
- 4. foster a stronger desire to purse further studies in mind sports and related disciplines.

#### Gifted Programme Introduction

Contract bridge is a mind sport which has been a favourite leisure activity of many celebrities, such as Bill Gates, Steve Jobs, Mao Zedong, Deng Xiaoping. It is also a discipline in the past two Asian Games.

Contract bridge is also a way to develop participants' soft skills, including logical thinking, emotional management, communication skills, discipline, concentration, and so on.

In this course, participants will learn about the rules, basic strategies, and etiquette of contract bridge, to build up a basic understanding of this mind sport.
