Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

1. explain the definition and basic concepts of diplomacy and its importance;
2. perceive modern Chinese history from multiple perspectives and a broader outlook to enhance the sense of mission in China;
3. contemplate the diplomatic strategies from the current global situation to understand the importance of empathetic thinking;
4. enhance the awareness of history and diplomacy by participating in experiential activities to strengthen national pride.

◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

"Diplomacy" originates from the ancient Greek "diploma", which originally referred to a folded document used to prove the identity of the holder and the passage and other rights granted. In the 18th century, the French began to call their officials who dealt with foreign embassies "diplomats," meaning people who negotiated on behalf of the government. The connotation involved in "diplomacy" generally refers to the art of procedures involved in handling international relations between sovereign and independent countries based on sovereign equality.

This course is to train gifted students at the primary school level to understand the importance of diplomacy through the modern history of the country, the current situation of the world, and diverse thinking, and through a visit to The Commissioner's Office of China's Foreign Ministry in the Hong Kong S.A.R to understand the country's diplomacy.
