Gifted Programme Introduction

Ems Telegram triggered diplomatic conflicts and led to the Franco-Prussian War. The Paris Peace Conference ignored China's rights and interests and led to the May Fourth Movement. Diplomacy is the art of correspondence and a test for the country.

The purpose of this course is to train gifted students at the secondary school level to understand the country's diplomacy through the modern history of the country and the world, the situation in today's world, and diverse thinking, and to explore the country through a visit to The Commissioner's Office of China's Foreign Ministry in the Hong Kong S.A.R. to explore diplomatic pace.
