

Gifted Programme Introduction

Law and Medicine are two of the most commonly chosen programmes by students in university. While many gifted students have the ability to excel in these two disciplines, they might not have a clear idea of the connections between them. This programme first provides lectures on both disciplines, and then explores the connections between the two. In the last session, a mock trial on medical law will also be held for students to implement their skills learnt.
