Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

1. recognise the importance of electricity and how it has transformed people's lives since the days before electrification;
2. identify the global climate issues and describe different types of zero-carbon energy;
3. reflect on contemporary lifestyle and practice sustainable living.

◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

CLP Pulse is the revitalised CLP clock tower building which was built in 1940 and used as the CLP headquarters for more than seven decades. Today, the iconic building has been turned into a cultural hub with multimedia exhibitions and offers a wide range of programmes and experiential activities for the public to treasure and enjoy, sustaining its decades-long bond with the Hong Kong community.

In this workshop, students will first follow a guided tour to go through the main exhibition “ElectriCity” in CLP Pulse. In the tour (of about 40 – 50 minutes) packed with stories, students can explore the way in which electricity – a relative novelty a century ago – has powered Hong Kong’s growth and brought many transformational changes to people’s lives. Students can also learn about a power company’s meticulous planning aimed at solving the energy trilemma, and enjoy different interactive, immersive activities that guide them towards the lifestyles of a greener future.

After the guided tour, student can enjoy a free time of about half an hour, in which they can explore other exhibitions (e.g., Our Home • Our History, Traces of Human Touch) themselves, or play more on the interactive exhibition items as they like.
