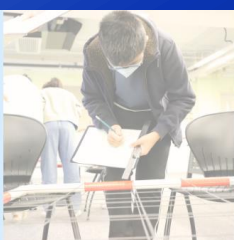

Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

1. outline basic theory of archaeology and underwater archaeology;
2. demonstrate knowledge and skills needed in underwater archaeology drawing, photography and diving;
3. develop awareness of collaboration, commitment and responsibility.

◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

Cultural relics reflect the lives of past humans, it let us understand the world from various perspectives all over the time. Underwater archaeology research is not limited to humanities and history, but also covers different fields including science, geography, art, and technology, which triggers our critical thinking.

Phase 1 included basic archaeology theory and covered practical workshops about underwater archaeology such as diving equipment, underwater drawing and underwater photography. In addition to theoretical knowledge, students can also understand research methods and equipment usage, and their collaboration can also be improved during group work.

The course consists of **THREE phases**. Selection for each phase will be based on students' performance.

Phase 2 and **Phase 3** are tentatively scheduled as below:

Phase 2: every Sat from 25 Jan 2025 to 8 Mar 2025

Phase 3: every Sat from 5 Apr 2025 to 17 May 2025
