Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

- 1. illustrate the features of traditional Chinese buildings;
- 2. discuss the relationship between Chinese architecture and traditional Chinese lifestyle;
- examine the feasibility of preserving the traditional way of life in the New Territories;
- 4. foster a stronger desire to pursue further studies in History and related disciplines.

Gifted Programme Introduction

Stroll along the Heritage Trail, connecting New Territories' historical gems.

The first of its kind in Hong Kong, the Ping Shan Heritage Trail was inaugurated on 12 December 1993. It links up a number of traditional Chinese buildings within easy walking distance of each other to provide students with an opportunity to learn more about traditional life in the New Territories in a convenient half-day excursion. In this workshop, students can explore traditional Chinese buildings such as ancestral halls, temples, study halls, and pagodas, which were used for ancestral worship, clan gatherings, and education. Students will also have the opportunity to discover the traditional and unique characteristics of life in the New Territories, such as the organisation of various ceremonies during festivals.
