

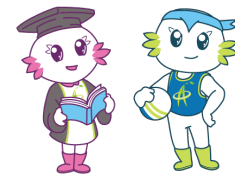

Upon completion of the programme, the participants should be able to:

1. Enhance logical thinking, perspective-taking and problem-solving skills to navigate challenging situations through experiential workshops and game-based learning;
2. Foster discipline, resilience, self-confidence and a positive mindset through physical activities;
3. Strengthen teamwork skills such as communication, goal setting, conflict resolution and task collaboration through adventurous activities;
4. Deepen awareness of the community, thereby enhancing a sense of belonging.

If student members withdraw from the programme after the Application Deadline, the token will be deducted.

◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

This leadership camp is one of the core programmes of the Leadership Training Programme Series.

The camp is designed to cultivate the next generation of leaders. It aims to enhance participants' leadership and teamwork skills through a series of structured activities that foster collaboration and inspire effective leadership. Additionally, attendees will engage in exercises that strengthen logical thinking and problem-solving abilities, encouraging innovative approaches to challenges. The camp will also focus on the development of discipline and resilience, essential attributes for overcoming obstacles in personal and professional pursuits. Lastly, it emphasizes the significance of social responsibility and national identity, guiding participants in understanding their vital roles within the community.
