Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

- 1. illustrate flood prevention works in Yuen Long Bypass Floodway;
- 2. explain the relationship between prevention works and wetland eco-system;
- 3. enhance their interest in ecology and to foster positive attitudes and actions towards ecological conservation..

Gifted Programme Introduction

Yuen Long Bypass Floodway is a 3.8 kilometres long drainage channel built at the south of Yuen Long Town. Different from the traditional river training works which increase the flow capacity of the rivers by straightening, widening and deepening the river channels, Yuen Long Bypass Floodway (YLBF) adopts the method of interception, intercepts 40% of the runoff in the Yuen Long Catchment, and then discharges the intercepted flow to the Deep Bay without passing through the Yuen Long Town, which reduces the flood risk of Yuen Long significantly.

In this workshop, student will gain a deeper understanding of river ecology and biodiversity in Hong Kong through observing elements of preservation of ecosystems in rivers incorporated into DSD's flood prevention works.
