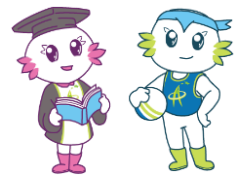

## **Intended Learning Outcomes**

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:
