### **Intended Learning Outcomes**

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

1. Classify archaeology discoveries of Maritime Silk Road from different periods;
2. Explain their research of Maritime Silk Road covering STEAM perspectives;
3. Illustrate archaeological, trading, cultural, technological and historical significance of Maritime Silk Road;
4. outline their insights into their archaeological, historical and/or cultural analysis.

## ◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

Cultural relics reflect the lives of past humans, it let us understand the world from various perspectives all over the time. Underwater archaeology research is not limited to humanities and history, but also covers different fields including science, geography, art, and technology, which triggers our critical thinking. Maritime Silk Road is an important topic for underwater archaeological research in China and symbolises the development of human civilisation.

In Phase 2, we will conduct in-depth study of the Maritime Silk Road, including underwater archaeology, cultural exchanges, transportation history, and navigation technology. To explore the major discoveries and value of the Maritime Silk Road, instructors will also share some unpublished research materials.

The course consists of **THREE phases**. Selection for each phase will be based on students' performance. **Phase 3** is tentatively scheduled as below:

- every Sat from 12 Apr 2025 to 17 May 2025 and weekdays during Easter holiday  
(\*outing will be arranged, such as sea demonstration)
