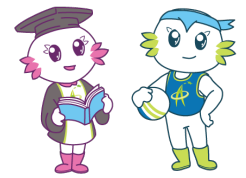

◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

The workshop offers gifted students an opportunity to immerse themselves in the natural world and discover the artistic potential of the Earth's raw materials. It will teach techniques to transform soil, clay, seeds, twigs, leaves, and other organic elements into captivating works of art. The workshop aims to introduce students to these techniques, help them understand the relationships between soil structure, soil components, and human interactions, and promote a sense of gratitude for the natural world and its abundant resources. Through hands-on experience, students will create their own artwork using a variety of organic materials.

By engaging in this creative process, gifted students can experience stress relief, as working with natural materials fosters mindfulness and relaxation. Additionally, the sense of accomplishment from creating unique pieces contributes to their emotional well-being, enhancing self-esteem and overall happiness.
