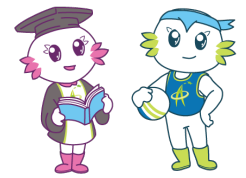

◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

The Sai Kung Hoi Arts Festival, a three-year initiative led by the Tourism Commission, with support from the Hong Kong Geopark and curation by One Bite Design Studio, unfolds across Yim Tin Tsai, Sharp Island, Kau Sai Chau (Kau Sai Village), High Island, and Sai Kung Town. By leveraging art, the festival invites visitors to delve into the rich natural resources and profound historical and cultural heritage of these islands, effectively transforming Sai Kung Hoi into an expansive outdoor gallery.

Participating in the guided tour of the Sai Kung Hoi Arts Festival provides students with an immersive journey through nature, historical buildings, and artistic creations. This experience is especially beneficial for gifted students as it enriches their understanding and appreciation of culture, nature, and art, nurturing their overall well-being and intellectual development.
