Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

1. classify the differences between various species of insects;
2. describe the importance of insects in ecology and human society;
3. examine the impacts of human activities on insects;
4. increase the responsibility of civil for ecological conservation.

◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

【Phase 2 - Insect Ecology and Society】

This phase involves ecological field trips and outdoor experiments to deepen students' understanding of insect diversity and classifications: Lepidoptera, Odonata, and Hymenoptera. Students will explore the ecological importance of insects, discuss human impacts on nature, and examine conservation responsibilities among various stakeholders.

【Phase 3 - Application and Group Study】

Students will conduct citizen science investigations based on selected topics. They will collect data during field studies, analyse what they find, and share their results during the last session.

Selection is based on students' performance in answering the question. Only students who can demonstrate motivation and the knowledge of biodiversity in the screening question can be enrolled in the programme
