Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

1. explain the diverse wetland ecosystems;
2. introduce the knowledge of wetland biodiversity and the significance of conservation efforts in safeguarding the ecosystems;
3. acquire birdwatching skills to identify diverse bird species within their natural habitats;
4. develop a heightened appreciation for the exceptional wetland scenery and biodiversity found in Mai Po;
5. create a further study plan in environmental science disciplines.

If student members withdraw from the programme after the Application Deadline, the token will be deducted.

◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

Mai Po Nature Reserve is situated at the center of the Mai Po Inner Deep Bay Ramsar Site (Wetland of International Importance). Mai Po, the sole wetland reserve in Hong Kong, holds extremely high ecological value.

This workshop will enable participants to visit various types of wetlands, including gei wai (traditional shrimp ponds), fishponds, mangroves, reed beds, freshwater marshes, etc., within the restricted area. For those new to Mai Po, you will not be disappointed by its unique wetland scenery and thriving biodiversity!
