Introduction

The Sharing Session is a pre-programme for Academy's Got Talents (STEAM) 2025/26 and Hong Kong Gifted Apprentice Programme (HKGAP) 2025/27. The Talent Development Division - Specialisation and Innovation of HKAGE will introduce the programme structure and schedule. Additionally, it will provide an opportunity for student members from different cohorts to share what they have learned and their achievements in both programmes.

Academy's Got Talents (STEAM) 2025/26

It aims to promote Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics (STEAM) within the academy. This programme identifies student members or teams who will have the opportunity to participate in upcoming STEAMrelated competitions or programmes, enriching their learning journey. The selection process evaluates participants not only based on their knowledge of relevant fields but also on their individual aptitude for self-directed learning and practical application.

HKGAP 2025/27

It is a 2-year and unique mentorship programme of The Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education (HKAGE), which provides students with an individualized and very privileged learning opportunity. One of the unique features of the HKGAP is the engagement of an apprentice and a master on a student self-initiated and specialised project. Apprentice is required to communicate with their Master on a regular basis and report on the progress of their project. Each apprentice must complete the selected self-initiated and specialized project before the end of the HKGAP.
