- 2. demonstrate how sea creatures reproduce and hatch;
- illustrate the impacts of human activities on the marine ecosystem and how to conserve sea creatures;
- 4. enhance their empathy and compassion on endangered species and environment;

Gifted Programme Introduction

The vast ocean is the habitat of many marine species.

Through lectures, observations and experiments, this workshop aims to give students an in-depth knowledge of the characteristics of marine creatures such as jellyfish and starfish. As well as deepening their understanding of marine life, students will also become aware of the importance of environmental conservation. This will be a rare opportunity for students to interact with marine creatures such as jellyfish, sea cucumbers and hermit crabs.

Led by Nikky, the founding curator of the Sea Jelly Spectacular at Hong Kong's Theme Park, the workshop will guide students in exploring the mysteries of the ocean and inspire curiosity about the natural world.
