The Kadoorie Conservation China Department (KCC) of Kadoorie Farm and Botanic Garden (KFBG) is dedicated to conserving threatened species and their ecosystems across Mainland China. One of its key initiatives focuses on protecting the Hainan Gibbon—a critically endangered primate that plays a vital role in forest regeneration. Apart from the biology and ecology of the gibbons, the KCC expert will share how the KCC team studyies the gibbons, the threats that the gibbons are facing and most importantly how different stakeholders can contribute to the conservation of the gibbons.
