This talk is one of the core programmes of the Leadership Training Programme Series 25/26, which focuses on the theme of inclusion.

The session will explore the important topic of inclusion, with a particular emphasis on students with special educational needs (SEN). It aims to deepen understanding of how to create a supportive and inclusive environment for all students. Key areas of discussion include the concept and importance of inclusive education in Hong Kong, what SEN represents and implications for students and the roles and responsibilities of leaders in supporting students with SEN in schools.

By the end of this talk, participants will be inspired to become advocates for inclusion, fostering an environment where every student is valued, supported, and empowered to succeed.
