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### Gifted Programme Introduction

Asia is a major hub for spread of emerging infectious diseases with significant public health and socioeconomic impact. The majority of emerging infectious diseases are caused by viruses that have crossed species barriers from animal reservoirs to humans. During an epidemic or pandemic, scientists and clinicians race against time to find out the modes of transmission, clinical manifestations, pathogenesis, diagnostics, therapeutics, vaccines, and non-pharmaceutical interventions of these emerging infectious diseases in order to minimize the damage they cause. In this talk, Professor Jasper Chan and Professor Shuofeng Yuan will use illustrative examples to demonstrate how we fight against emerging infectious diseases with particular relevance to Hong Kong.




