The Hon Tang was awarded the Medal of Honour by the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) in 2013 and his current public offices include vice-president of The Hong Kong Federation of Education Workers (FEW), member of The Chongqing Municipal Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (CPPCC), member of The CDC-HKEAA Committee on Liberal Studies, and part-time lecturer of Master of Education Programme in CUHK.
