Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

- 1. demonstrate a comprehensive understanding of the Procreate application;
- 2. apply realistic drawing techniques;
- 3. create diverse digital artworks using various illustration styles
- 4. develop confidence and a creative mindset to explore and experiment with digital illustration techniques in Procreate.

Gifted Programme Introduction

This programme masters students in illustration with A.I. features. In Phase 1, it introduces gifted students to Procreate, guiding them through its interface, tools, and brush customisation. Students will learn to create realistic sketches with techniques and explore diverse artistic styles, helping them achieve stunning effects and textures. Students will develop confidence and a creative mindset to explore and experiment with digital illustration techniques in Procreate.

The course consists of **THREE phases**. Selection for each phase will be based on students' performance.

Phase 2 and Phase 3 are tentatively scheduled as below:

Phase 2: every Sat from 28 Feb 2026 to 25 Apr 2026

Phase 3: every Sat from 16 May 2026 to 1 Aug 2026
