◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

The Earth has been in existence for more than 4 billions years. Human beings have existed for a very short period of time. Prior to our existence, the Earth's environment and living things have changed dramatically many times. There have been all sorts of mysterious ancient creatures that existed in different geological eras. But... have you ever seen the evidence of the existence of these ancient creatures?

In this course, starting with the basic concepts of paleontology and fossils, learn about geological time and the various types of ancient creatures in each era. Students can visit and touch the fossils. By the end of the programme, students will be provided to a chance to retrieve a real fossil sample and take it home for collection.
